The variety of species brought to the scales was impressive, highlighting once again what a really great winter season we have had. The Snoek were out in full force off the Umgeni River mouth on Saturday morning and even with the huge fleet of boats in the area, almost everyone managed multiple fish.

Besides the Snoek, a few good-sized Garrick were caught, measured, and safely released, and species brought to the scales included multiple Black Musselcracker, Kob, Bek, Red fish, and a big Bonnie.

In the end, **Joel Egling** swooped in to win the Monthly Mug for the second consecutive month, with a brilliant Kob of 27.5kg.

Chloe Terblanche won the Lady's category with a Daga of 14.56kg, **Connor Malton** took the 13 - 18-year-olds Junior section with a 1kg Soldier and Miss **Charlotte Joyce** won the 4 -12 y/o category with a brilliant 8.28kg Bonnie, and while it won no prizes, Charlotte's dad, **Graham Joyce** hooked an excellent Scotsman on a jig that tipped the scales at 5.30kgs.

Possibly the most remarkable catch on Saturday though, was a massive, estimated 31kg Copper Steenbras, hooked by **Bruce Jackson**. After a quick photo, Bruce spent a considerable amount of time ensuring the fish was safely released and given the best chance to survive.

Finally, we would like to wish **Don Foti** a speedy recovery after his KP broke and seriously injured his hand during Saturday's competition.
