Christine Black will be kicking off the weekend with live music on Friday from 5pm to 8pm, and Igal will be setting the Sunday mood from 1pm to 4pm.

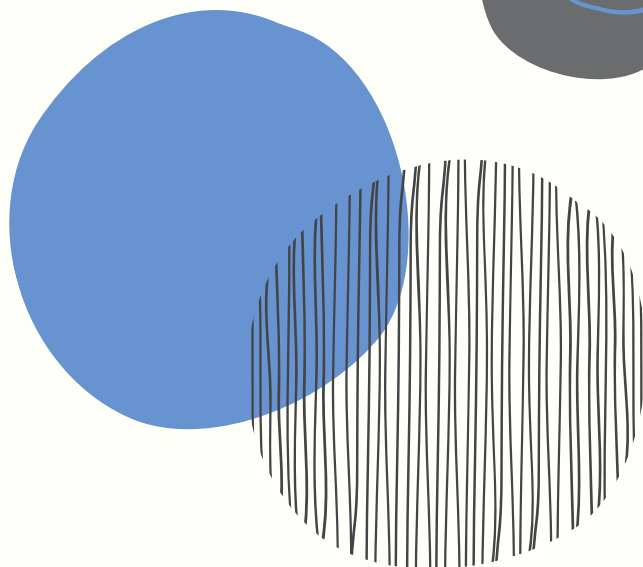
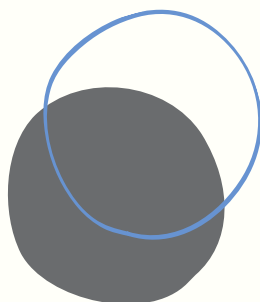
