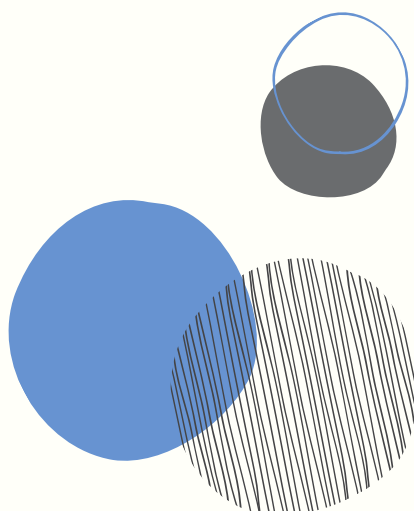

After the strong mid-week winds, we look set for another great fishing-weather weekend, and if the UKFC Kayak Fishing Competition's results from the past weekend are anything to go by, there are plenty of good Couta to target. During the 2-day competition, 8 Couta over 20 kgs were weighed and loads more just under the 20kg mark. The winning fish came in at 27.65 kg. Numerous reports have started coming in of pilot shoals of sardines passing the Kei River mouth and even up as far as Cob Inn. With more big cold fronts forecast for late next week, we could see water temperatures drop enough for the annual sardine run to begin. This almost certainly will slow the game fishing down, so now is definitely the time to get some Couta fishing in.

Also, over the past weekend, DSBC had teams competing in the Shelly Beach Interclub competition. Our teams put up a valiant fight, with the **Durban White** team finishing in 6th place after having no fish weighed on the 1st day of the tournament. Once again, our junior anglers impressed, landing some very decent catches before the sharks arrived. Also worth mentioning is that the Natal Interzonal side, captained by DSBC angler **James Fourie**, managed to take 2nd place.

This coming weekend, we have one senior and 2 junior teams representing DSBC at the Umhlanga Interclub Competition, which will be running at the same time as the Natal Gamefish Interprovincial Tournament, also hosted by Umhlanga. We wish **Cornel Van Zyl**, fishing for Natal White, and **James Fourie**, captaining a Barbarian side with Northern Gauteng, all the best and tight lines for the tournament.

The **Interprovincial Tournament** kicks off on Friday, and the Interclub Competition begins on Saturday morning, so expect to see a few more boats on the water this weekend.

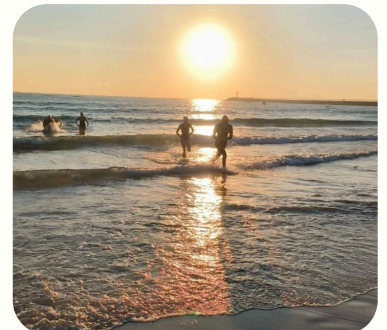
