We're also thrilled to announce that the **Kids Beach Party** is back on for this **Sunday, 20 July**. Bring the little ones down for some fun in the sun.

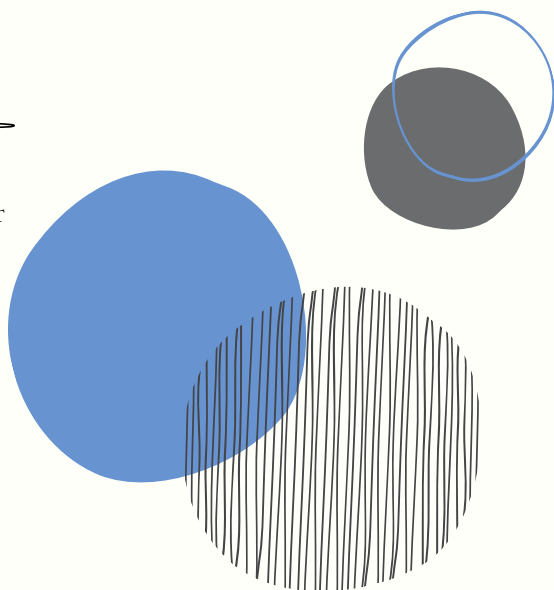

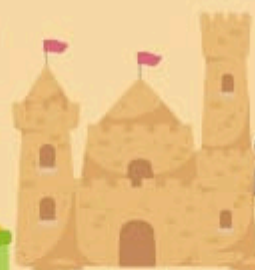

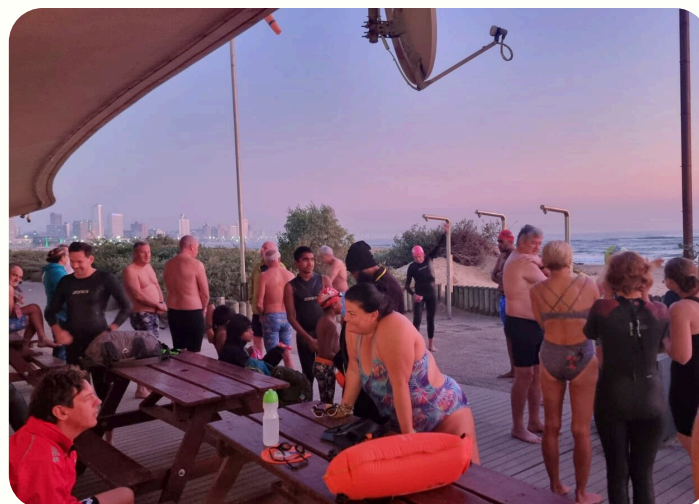


NITE SERIES SWIM LAUNCHES NEXT WEEK

Please note: this new material is textured and can be abrasive, especially to wet, unprotected hands. We strongly recommend that all divers wear gloves when boarding or exiting the boat to avoid injury
