With the days getting longer and the warmer weather setting in, there's no better time to spend an afternoon or evening at the club.

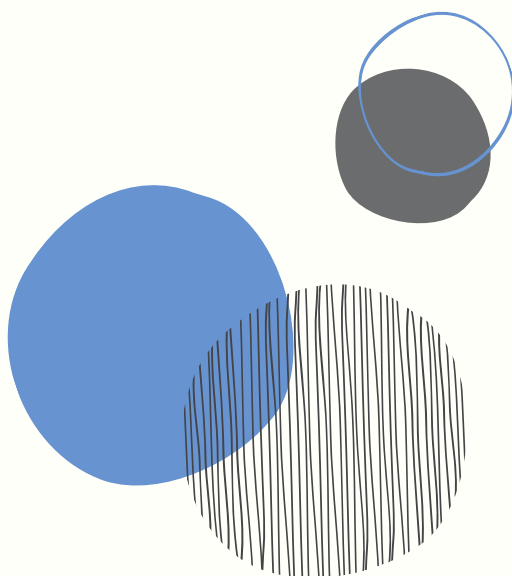
Whether it's enjoying the view, catching up with friends, or relaxing with good music, we look forward to hosting you.

OPEN WATER SWIMMING

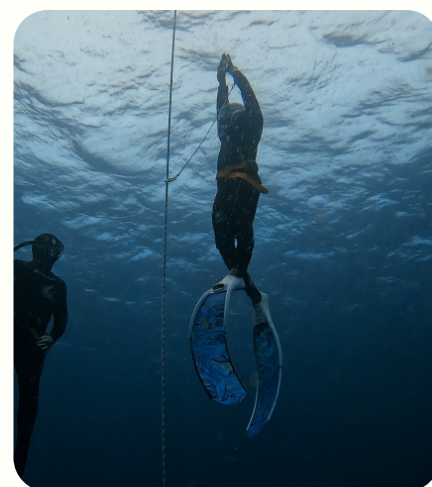
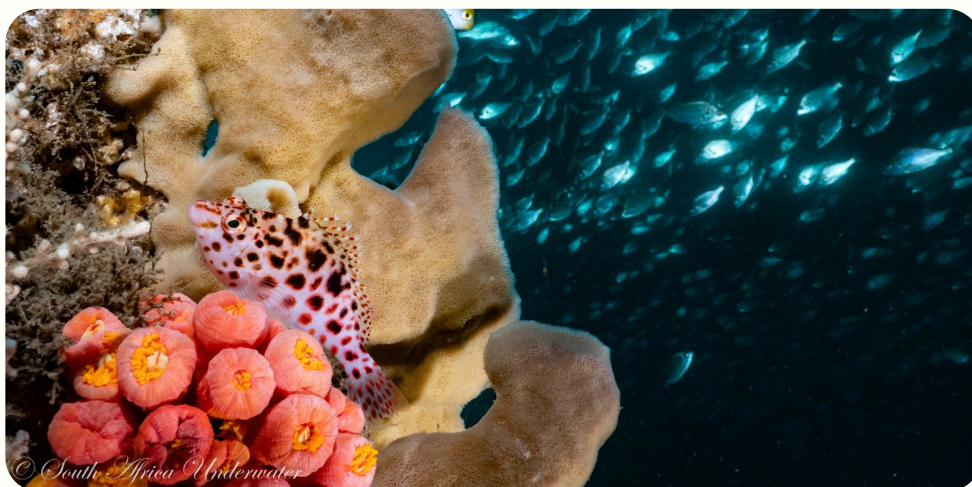
