- **Sunday** Hale Mary 13h00 to 16h00

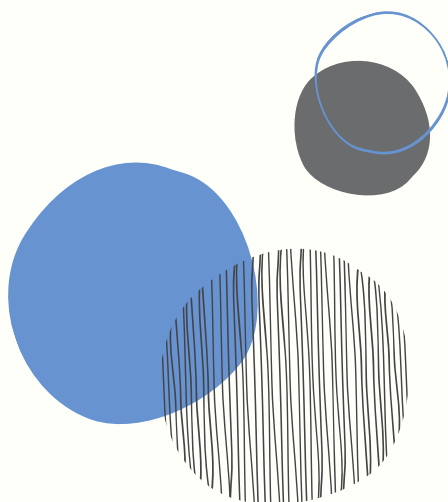
The club will be open on Tuesday under public holiday trading hours, with **JP Dix** entertaining us with live music from 13h00 to 16h00.

December is definitely off to a cracking start for fisherfolk! The last week has produced some really excellent catches, even with the limited weather windows. Quite a few Sailfish have been hooked, and even a Marlin or two. There have been some impressive Couta coming out, among the many caught, and even Cape Yellowtail have popped up on a few occasions. As hoped for, Dorado are everywhere, again, with some really impressive sizes in the mix. We are absolutely spoiled for choice at the moment. For the bottom fishermen, great catches of geelbek and Daga are still being reported, and there is an excellent variety of reef species coming out too. Our congratulations go to one of our young lady stars, **Kerralyn Williams**, on taking 3rd place in the U/16 juniors' category at the Umhlanga Ladies & Juniors competition on Sunday, with a 5.58kg Dorado.

DSBC has an extremely strong and talented group of competitive anglers, many of whom have achieved provincial, SADSAA, and even Protea colours in our sport, and who had a very successful 2025. On Saturday, **18 January** next year, we will be holding the 2026 competitive anglers meeting. This meeting is compulsory for all current competitive anglers wishing to continue their journey towards provincial colours and beyond. We had a very strong group of younger anglers this year and would like to see this area grow, so if you or your children would like to start competitive angling, please attend this meeting too.
